## **Keeping Kids In Mind**

## **Circle of Security Parenting**

You may often wonder "What does my child want from me?" In this five week course you will learn about the Circle of Security parenting program. It explains how children look to their parents or caregivers for support as they move from their need for safety and security to their needs for exploration. Hear about ways to identify your children's needs and step by step approaches for promoting secure attachment in children. Suitable for parents of children of all ages but particularly focuses on infants and young children.

## My Kids & Me

## **Bringing Up Great Kids**
